TITLE: YESHUA’S GENEALOGIES THROUGH ZADOK, JOSEPH, AND MARY

WHAT IS THIS?

In this resource we aim to show how Levitical High Priest Zadok’s DNA mixed into Judah’s DNA so that Yeshua’s DNA qualified Him to be King and High Priest, both positions being subsumed into the Melchizedek order as they were before Jacob split it between two sons.

Rhesa Joanna Judah Joseph Semei Mattathias Maath Nagge Esli Nahum Amos Mattathias Joseph Janna Melchi Levi Matthat & Heli >Mary >Yeshua the <u>Messiah</u>	Zadok’s genealogy shows where the high priesthood DNA mixed with David’s: Zadok II’s daughter, Jerusha, married King Azariah of Solomon’s line and produced King Jotham. It also shows that Mary’s mother Hannah was of Zadok, being Yeshua III’s daughter, and that she married Heli from Nathan’s line. Joseph’s genealogy shows how Yeshua legally inherited kingship (Matthew 1:6) via adoption as well as providing opportunity to show how the three lines mixed together. Mary’s genealogy shows how Nathan’s line intermarried with Solomon’s at Neri: Neri married Josiah’s daughter Tamar and produced Salathiel, but then he died and Tamar married Jeconiah, who adopted Salathiel. This allowed Solomon’s kingly line to continue despite Jeconiah being judged for wickedness, the punishment being that he would not have a son to sit on the throne. Salathiel produced Zerubbabel, whose sons continued the lines of Nathan and Solomon, so that Yeshua descended from Zadok and Solomon <i>and</i> Nathan. Since Israel was not in control of its throne at the time of His birth, Yeshua would not have been a king when He was on earth. Does that phrase sound familiar? It’s what was said of Yeshua in Hebrews 8:4. “If then He were on earth, He would not be a priest, since there are those who offer gifts according to the law.” Political and religious conditions were such that Yeshua would not have been permitted to serve as king or as high priest! Everything was totally corrupted. Herod had usurped the kingship and indeed, tried to kill Yeshua when He was a baby because he was afraid of losing his throne. Others had usurped the priesthood so He would not have been permitted to serve in the temple, either. But wait. Would you <i>want</i> Him to serve in the temple? If He had been the high priest on earth, He would have had to offer animal sacrifices which could never take away sins (Hebrews 10:11). That would have run contrary to His purpose in coming to be our Redeemer. The only way He could redeem mankind was to offer Himself because He was perfect and holy. Only His blood could take away sins and the only way to offer it was to die. Once dead He could not have offered sacrifices in the temple on earth. The only way He could serve as our high priest now is in heaven as the Melchizedek! And that’s perfect because the Melchizedek position is restored. No longer is it split between two tribes (Judah and Levi) and no longer is it being done by a fallible man (Adam, Noah, Shem, etc.), but it is being done by Yeshua Messiah, the sinless Son of YHWH!
