TITLE: YESHUA’S GENEALOGY + COVENANT PROMISES

WHAT IS THIS?

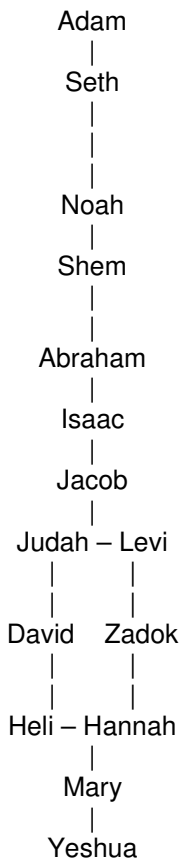


Yeshua, the Messiah, firstborn of all creation, is His brother’s keeper. He was always intended to be the One through Whom YHWH provided for His precious creation, having been “the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world” (Revelation 13:8). When Adam sinned and lost dominion of the earth to Satan, YHWH promised to send His Son to crush the serpent’s head (Genesis 3:15) and restore everything. In the meantime, righteous men were to be Melchizedeks; potential candidates from Adam to Jacob are listed below. Then the firstborn responsibilities were divided temporarily into priesthood and kingship. Yeshua fulfills the covenant in those two positions in two comings:

- 1) **SUFFERING SERVANT:** When Yeshua was crucified at Golgotha, the serpent bruised His heel and it looked like He had lost. However, His death was necessary to atone for our sin and to allow Him to become our Melchizedek High Priest in heaven so as to mediate for us continually before the Father. He could not take the Levitical High Priest position on earth because He had to move on and fulfill the requirements of the kingly role.
- 2) **CONQUERING KING:** Once the anti messiah (antichrist) gets the whole world under his control (making it look like he won), Yeshua will return and end his rule (crush his head). He will reign as King with His resurrected people for a thousand years, defeat death forever, and then restore the Kingdom back to His Father.

Created from the dust. He and Eve had dominion over the earth until they sinned.

Cain killed Abel, disqualifying himself. Elohim gave Seth in their place. Seth’s generations: Enosh, Kenan, Mahahalel, Jared, Enoch (seventh from Adam, who walked with Elohim and was taken), Methuselah, and Lamech (father of Noah).

Righteous in all his generations, chosen to be saved with seven others on the ark.

Generally believed to be the Melchizedek that Abraham met but it could have been Eber. Shem’s generations: Arkipadshad, Shelah, Eber, Peleg, Reu, Nahor, Terah, and Abraham.

Believed Elohim and it was counted to him as righteousness. Covenant established.

Abraham’s miraculous promised son. Covenant re-affirmed.

Isaac’s chosen one, name changed to Israel. Elohim continued covenant through Israel.

Jacob split the firstborn responsibilities between two sons. Judah had twin sons with Tamar, who was also a descendant of Shem. Levi’s wife was Melka.

King David was a descendant of Judah. David was given the kingship forever. Zadok was a descendant of Levi. High Priest Zadok was given the priesthood forever.

Prince Heli (a descendant of David) married Hannah (a daughter of a Zadok high priest).

Daughter of Heli and Hannah. Betrothed to Joseph, whose lineage was through Judah.

Son of Mary and adopted son of Joseph. The firstborn responsibilities were brought back together in Him. Yeshua qualified as King of Judah, Levitical High Priest, Melchizedek.
